

UNISON MEMBERS CONSULTATION MEETINGS ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET CUTS AND CHANGES TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PENSION SCHEME

With £60m cuts threatening up to 400 jobs at the City Council, staff facing pay cuts and thousands of vulnerable people facing withdrawal of their Voluntary sector support, City Services are in crisis.

Despite a successful protest on 22 February 2011, the Executive Board approved the budget cuts and it is likely that the budget will be agreed at the Full Council Meeting in early March. Nottingham City UNISON was appalled to hear the scale of the cuts which will tear into the heart of services for many of Nottingham's most vulnerable citizens

There are also proposals for major attacks to the Local Government Pension Scheme.
